ACTING AND

All members who express an interest in acting are notified of the audition by email and on social media. usually two or three weeks in advance of the audition date. Rehearsals generally take place two or three nights a week, for 8 – 10 weeks before the production starts. Directors are chosen from a core of acting members and may have acted as production assistants, in order to shadow a director and understand what's required.



We always need talented actors as we cast our plays but if acting isn't your thing, you've definitely got some of the skills we could use to get our productions off the ground.

If you can use a hammer and/or a paint brush you can build sets, if you can sew and alter costumes you can dress a cast, if you have a sense of design, you can dress sets and muster appropriate props, if you have technical ability, you can provide lighting and sound from the gallery. The Front of House volunteers staff the box office, the sweet kiosk, the coffee lounge and the bar.

So join us and we'll welcome you with open arms and make sure you have the training to get the most out of your new hobby.

Box Office staff are at the theatre each night throughout production dates for bookings, purchase of season tickets and gift vouchers.

The Front of House team welcome the public to WLT and are responsible for ensuring patrons find their seats, answering any queries or problems they may have.

The catering team sells sweets before the show and coffee and ice cream in the interval.

The Wardrobe Department makes, hires and supplies suitable costumes for every production.

Design, construction and painting of the sets for each production is the foundation of a successful production.

Members of the prompt team are never seen - and hopefully never heard! during the run of a production.

The Props Department looks after the hire, making or purchasing of the practical accessories and furniture that decorate our sets.

TECHNICAL SUPPORT

The Technical Support Team are responsible for the design and operation of the lighting and sound for each production.

Before the show the bar team whips up patrons drinks and takes interval orders. Last orders are at 10.40pm before calling it a night at 11.00p.m...
